**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** HRC AV Rules apply \* HRC AV Members must present current membership & performance cards to Card Secretary 30 mins prior to competing \* Riders must wear Club Uniform, failure to do so will result in Rider riding HC \* All riders to present to gear check 20mins before first test – failure to do so will result in elimination \* One rider per horse \* Tests may be called \* Riders to provide own numbers (both sides of horse) \* All riders must wear approved helmets \* Medical armbands to be worn in jumping phases \* No refunds unless a vet or doctors certificate is produced within 7 working days after the event \* GRC and the reserve will not be held responsible for any accident, injury or illness to horse, riders or spectators throughout the competition \* Protests must be accompanied by \$20, to be forfeited if dismissed \* The organisers reserve the right to change the program without notice \* Dogs are permitted but must be on a lead at all times.
